

**This is one of a series of factsheets that present preliminary data from the survey conducted by the Filipino Youth Transitions in Canada project.**

**Q. How many of our survey respondents took a university/degree route after high school and how many took other pathways?**

A. So far, most of our respondents (about 2/3rds) have followed a university/degree path after high school. The proportion is about the same in Toronto, Vancouver and Winnipeg. This is interesting, especially when considered alongside Factsheet #4, which shows that Winnipeg parents are much less likely to be degree holders.
