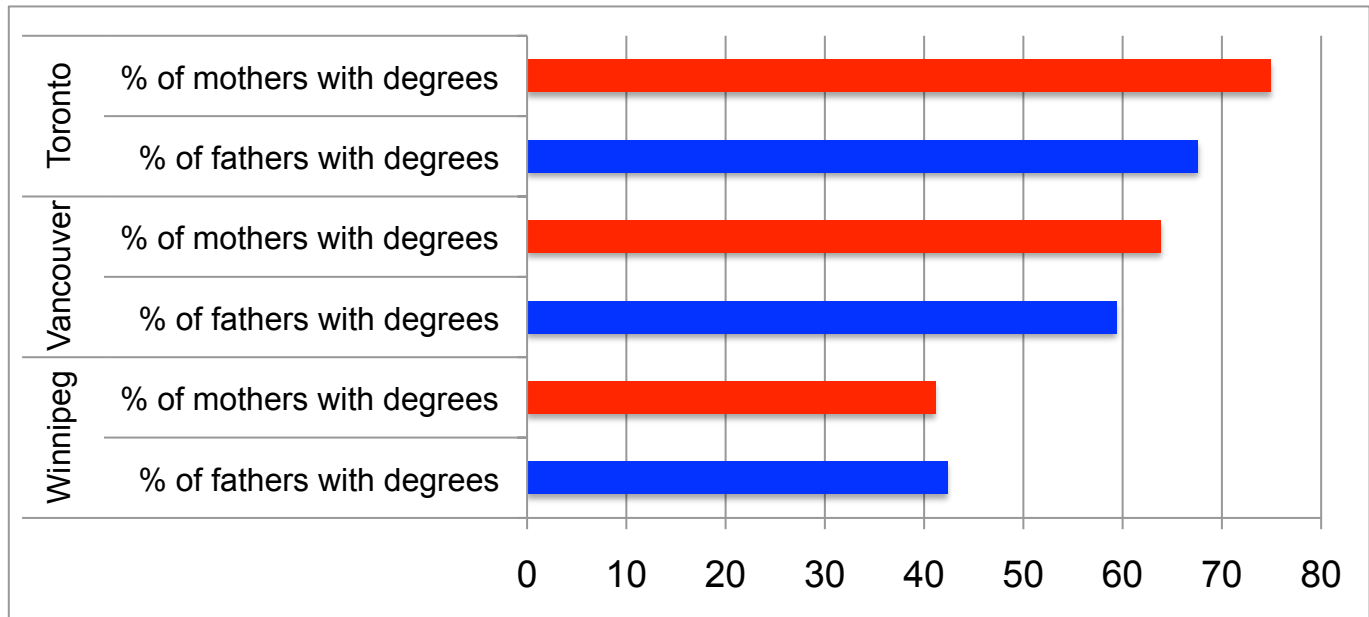


This is one of a series of factsheets that present preliminary data from the survey conducted by the Filipino Youth Transitions in Canada project.

Q. What proportion of Filipino parents are university degree holders?

A. In Vancouver and Toronto, the mothers of our survey respondents are slightly more likely to be degree holders than the fathers. Across the country, parents are much more likely to hold degrees in Vancouver or Toronto than in Winnipeg. This reflects a different history of immigration in Winnipeg, using different immigration categories.
