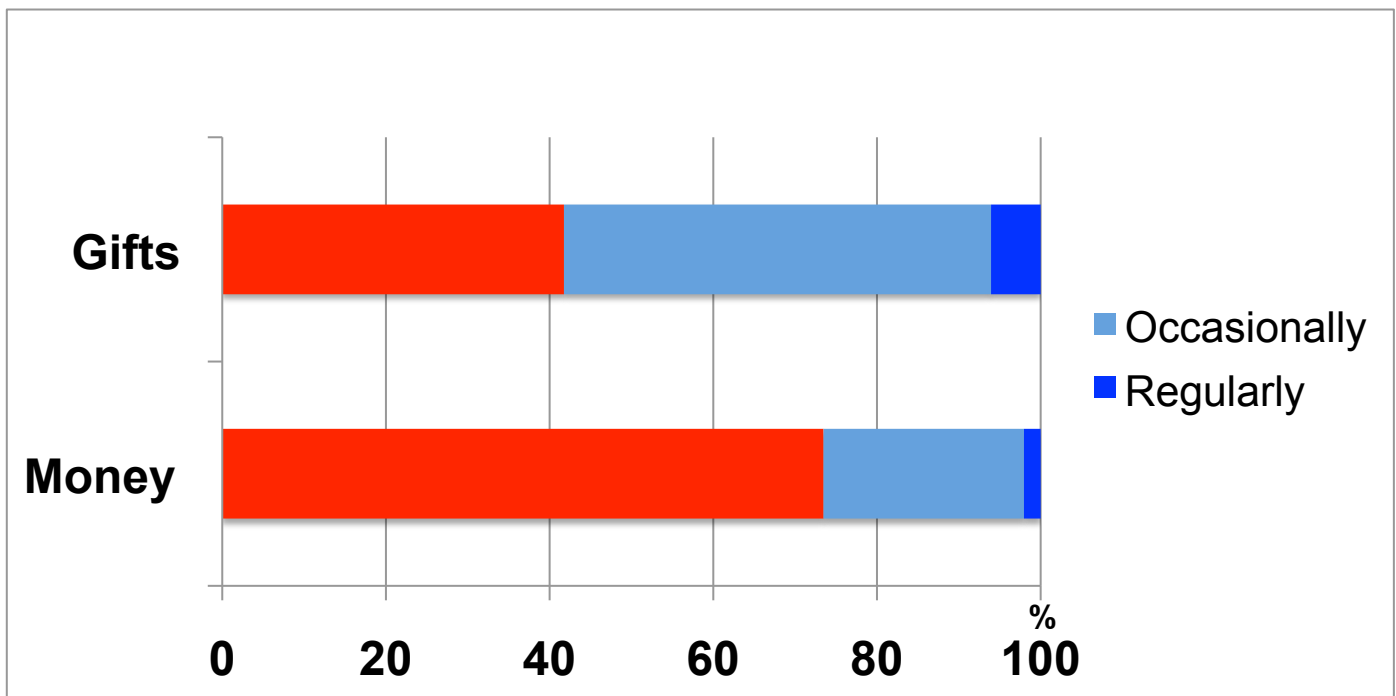


This is one of a series of factsheets that present preliminary data from the survey conducted by the Filipino Youth Transitions in Canada project.

Q. Do second generation Filipino-Canadians ever send money or gifts to relatives in the Philippines?

A. Over half of second generation Filipino Canadians (i.e. individuals born in Canada) send gifts occasionally or regularly to relatives in the Philippines. But only around a quarter send money on a regular or occasional basis.
