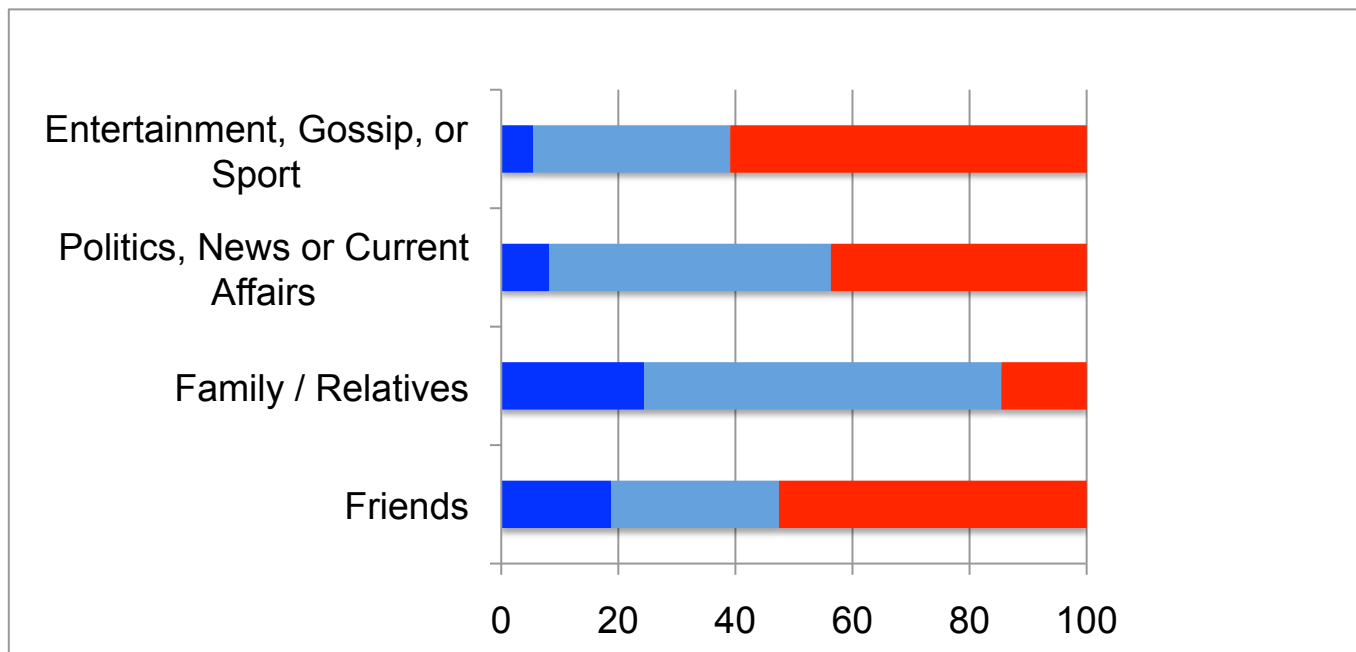


This is one of a series of factsheets that present preliminary data from the survey conducted by the Filipino Youth Transitions in Canada project.

Q. Do second generation Filipino-Canadians (born in Canada) stay in touch with friends, family and current events in the Philippines using social media, such as Facebook and Twitter?

A. Over 80% of 2nd generation Filipino-Canadians stay in touch with family members in the Philippines on a frequent or occasional basis. Just under half stay in touch with friends in the Philippines, and just over half follow current affairs. Fewer follow entertainment, gossip and sport in the Philippines.
